

The Petitioner raises the following issues to be decided by the Court:

1. Whether the Administrator of the Drug Enforcement Administration failed to follow the administrative procedures set out in 21 C.F.R. § 1308.44(c) when he refused to accept the Petitioner's petition for rule making on the grounds that the petition lacked merit.
2. Whether the Administrator of the Drug Enforcement Administration erred in ruling that a synthetic molecule, dronabinol, 21 C.F.R. § 1308.12(f)(1), is not the same thing as the naturally occurring molecule extracted from its vegetable origin.


