IT IS ORDERED:

1. The above-entitled case is scheduled for a jury trial before the Honorable Laurie Smith Camp, District Court Judge, to begin **Tuesday, December 16, 2008 at 9:00 a.m.** in Courtroom No. 2, Third Floor, Roman L. Any motions for a continuance of this trial date shall be electronically filed on or before **December 2, 2008** and shall (a) set forth the reasons why the moving party believes that the additional time should be allowed and (b) justify the additional time, ***citing specific references to the appropriate section(s) of the Speedy Trial Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3161 et seq.*** Any defense motion for continuance shall be accompanied by a written affidavit signed by the defendant in accordance with [NECrimR](#) 12.1.

3. Counsel for the United States shall confer with defense counsel and, no later than **December 8, 2008**, advise the court of the anticipated length of trial.
