COMES NOW Dejay Monson, by and through his attorney and moves this Court to review the conditions of his pretrial release and to remove the requirement that he have no contact with Bill Compton. Defendant alleges that Bill Compton and his wife are close personal friends of Defendant and his wife, Dana Monson. In the past, when Mr. Compton's father died, Defendant was Mr. Compton's closest friend. When Defendant's mother died, Mr. Compton was Defendant's second closest friend (only his wife, Dana was more directly involved in helping Defendant deal with the loss of his mother).

Dana Monson has been diagnosed with cancer and is currently undergoing radiation and chemotherapy. Dana Monson is not expected to survive more than a few weeks. Defendant is hoping for permission to have Bill Compton and his wife come visit Dana Monson and to be able to provide friendship and support to Defendant.

Bill Compton has a pending state court felony drug charge, however there is no restriction on whom he can associate with. The only legal barrier to their ongoing friendship is this Court's pretrial release order. Defendant respectfully asks this Court to remove the no contact provisions as they relate to Bill Compton and his wife. Defendant also avers that he has had no pretrial release violations in this case.

Counsel has contacted Kimberly C. Bunjer, the assigned prosecutor, who indicated that she does not oppose this motion.
